**Revised Order**

Whereas, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section(2) of Section 32 of the National Council for Teacher Education Act, 1993(73 of 1993), and in supersession of the National Council for Teacher Education [Recognition Norms and Procedure] Regulations, 2009, the National Council for Teacher Education has notified the Regulations, 2014 on 01.12.2014.

2. And whereas, the Dnyanganga College Of Education, Zeal Education Societys S.No.25/3/3. Hingne Khurd, Sinhagad Road, pune 411051 Maharashtra by affidavit dt. 20.01.2015 has consented to come under new Regulations and sought for two basic units in B.Ed, which require additional facilities

3. And whereas, it has been decided to permit the institution to have two basic units of 50 students each subject to the institution fulfilling following conditions namely,

- I. The institution shall create additional facilities that include (a) additional built-up area, (b) additional infrastructure, (c) additional funds, (d) additional staff as per Regulations, 2014 and inform Regional Committees with required documents by October 31, 2015.
- II. The applicant-institution for additional unit will be required to submit the required documents such as land documents, Encumbrance Certificate (EC), Land Use Certificate (LUC), Building Plan (BP) and the Approved Staff List in the specified proforma available on the website to the Regional Committee in proof of having provided additional facilities before October 31, 2015. Building Completion Certificate (BCC) may be given along with other documents if available, otherwise it can also be given to the Visiting team at the time of inspection.
- III. The Regional Committees shall arrange for verification of documents, inspection of these premises and check adherence to these conditions by 20 Feb, 2016. If it is found by the Regional Committee that the institution fails to comply with these requirements, the institutions shall not be permitted to admit students for the academic year 2016-2017.
- IV. In case any existing institution's matter is sub-judice under court direction/SCN under section 17 of the NCTE Act/Complaint etc., the institution shall be required to submit a copy of the Hon'ble Court order/reply to SCN/complaint/already submitted alongwith the documents, if any together the documents referred above. In case the institution's request for shifting of premises is pending, such institutions shall be required to submit the requisite documents as per provisions of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 with a copy of the order/NOC of the affiliating body/State Govt. and such other documents as indicated in the revised format recognition order. The final decision shall be subject to the directions given by the Hon'ble Court in the Writ Petition/case decided by the Western Regional Committee in respect of Section 17/complaint cases etc.

4. Now therefore, in the light of the above and in accordance with the **NCTE Regulations, 2014, the Western Regional Committee (NCTE) hereby issues the revised recognition order to Dnyanganga College Of Education, Zeal Education Societys S.No.25/3/3, Hingne Khurd, Sinhagad Road, pune 411051 Maharashtra for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) from the academic session 2015-16 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned herein before 31.10.2015.**

- h) Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
- i) The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
- j) The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. if it so desires.
- k) Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.

If institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made and issued there under, the institution will render itself liable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the Regional Committee under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993.

**CONTINUATION ORDER**

**WHEREAS**, WRC-NCTE had granted permission to the institution namely DNYANGANGA COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, ZEAL EDUCATION SOCIETYS S.No. 25/3/3, HINGNE KHURD, SINHAGAD ROAD, PUNE 411051, MAHARASHTRA vide order No. WRC/2-32/123223/73/2005/4887 dated. 27.06.2005.for conducting B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students.

2. **AND WHEREAS**, the Revised Recognition order was issued to the institution vide dated 28.05.2015 for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 100 students with a direction to submit the compliance to the Revised Recognition order on or before 31.10.2015.

3. As no compliance to the revised recognition order was received, the matter was considered by WRC in its 255<sup>th</sup> meeting and as per the decision of WRC, Show Cause Notice for non-submission of compliance was issued vide dated: 31.03.2017.

4. The institution has not submitted any reply to the Show Cause Notice dated 31.03.2017. The matter was considered by WRC in its 311<sup>th</sup> meeting, wherein the committee decided to withdraw the recognition under Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 for B.Ed. programme with effect from the end of the academic session next following the date of communication of the said order.

*Accordingly, withdrawal order was issued to the institution on 10.10.2019.*

5. **AND WHEREAS**, the institution filed an appeal to the Appellate Authority Hqrs. And the Appellate Authority vide order dated 02.03.2020 remands back the case to WRC.

6. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the WRC in its 316<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 27<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> August & 04<sup>th</sup> September 2020 and the Committee decided as under: -

*The Committee considered the matter in view of the order of the Appellate Authority, Agenda Note and observed the following: -*

- *The institution has not submitted any compliance in response to order of the Appellate Authority.*

*In view of the above, the Committee decided that last opportunity be given to the institution to submit documents within 30 days u/s 17 of the NCTE Act for B.Ed. course.*

*Accordingly, Final Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 21.09.2020.*

7. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by WRC in its 324<sup>th</sup> meeting, wherein the committee decided as under: -

The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the following observation was made that:

1. The original FDRs of Rs 5.00 lakh and Rs. 7.00 lakh in joint mode not submitted.
2. The submitted land documents are in Marathi Language. The institution is required to submit the same in translated version.
3. In the submitted affidavit the date of registration of land documents not mentioned.

**In view of the above, the Committee decided that last opportunity be given to the institution to reply within 30 days u/s 14 of the NCTE Act for B.Ed. programme.**

8. **AND WHEREAS**, the matter was considered by the WRC in its 326<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 22<sup>nd</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2021 and the Committee decided as under: -

The original file of the Institution along-with other related documents were carefully considered and examined by WRC in the light of NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations and Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and the Committee observed as under:

The institution has submitted all required documents which were considered by the Committee and found fit the case for issuance of Recognition continuation order.

**In view of above, the Committee decided as under:**

**Recognition of the institution be continued for the B.Ed. programme with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each).**

7. **NOW THEREFORE**, the recognition granted to the institution for conducting B.Ed. course has been continued with an annual intake of 100 students (two basic units of 50 students each) as per decision of the WRC in its 326<sup>th</sup> meeting.

8. The institution shall continuously adhere the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended time to time and any deviation from it shall be liable for action, against the institution, as stipulated under NCTE Act, Rules and NCTE Regulations.
